

Bankable Energy Efficiency Projects - BEEP

BEEP was a two-year project designed to develop bankable investment projects for improving energy efficiency in selected Central and Eastern European (CEE) countries and completed in February 2005. BEEP had the target to find and fully develop at least one bankable investment project for improving energy efficiency in each participating CEE country, and prepare each project's funding application to the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) or other financial institutions. This work also included selecting appropriate national or international investors for the preferred model of third-party financing by private service companies.

BEEP was financed by the EU SAVE programme. The Co-financing of the Austrian Energy Agency's participation in the project was provided by the Austrian Federal Ministry for Agriculture, Forestry, Environment and Water Management.
